

SOUTHSIDE SPEEDWAY 2012 VIOLATIONS AND DISCIPLINARY ACTION

In the interest of Southside Speedway to ensure the fairness of competition and the orderly conduct of the event the following penalties for the violations will apply. The violations and the resulting penalties are to be used by Southside Speedway and management as general guidelines for violations of track rules. The severity of each violation will be the interpretation of track officials and is non-appealable and such penalties may include but not be limited to suspensions and/or permanent loss of track license. All competitors, drivers, crew members, spotters, owners, sponsors and others with track license are responsible for their conduct at all times whether participating in an event, driver's meeting, spotter's stand or as a spectator. This applies to all contact with Southside Speedway management, staff and officials as well as the press and other electronic media both at the track and away from the track. All rulings are at the discretion of track officials including any actions taken that are deemed necessary and not described below.

Unsportsmanlike conduct including profanity, racial slurs and unruly behavior	Suspension/fine/probation/reduction of points
Fighting	Suspension/fine/probation/reduction of points
Abuse of official	Suspension/fine/probation/reduction of points
Abuse language/gestures within if sight of grandstands	Suspension/fine/probation/reduction of points
Spinning another car out	Move to rear of the field
Intentionally spinning car out	Parked for remainder of race/disqualification from event/suspension/fine/probation/reduction of points

Hitting car under yellow	Move to rear of field/parked for remainder of event/disqualification/suspension/probation/reduction of points
Hitting car on cool down lap or on pit road before, during or after event	Suspension/fine/probation/reduction of points
Failure to comply with tech inspection	Disqualification from event/suspension/fine/probation/reduction of points
Car too low after race (within 1 inch)	Last place points for the event
Car too low after race (more than 1 inch)	Disqualification from event
Car too light	Disqualification from event
Engine not meeting specs	Disqualification from event
Suspension not meeting specs	Disqualification from event
Tire soaking	Disqualification from event/\$500 fine/suspension
Any violation not deemed competitive advantage	Suspension/fine/probation/reduction of points
Any electronic device or possession of device which will enhance traction capabilities or used for recording of data whether in working order or not unless approved by track officials	Suspension up to 1 year
Any member who partakes of any alcoholic beverage, stimulant or other drug while participating in the event as driver or crew	Suspension of 30 days to permanent suspension
Any member who allows another person to use their track license, signs the sign in sheet for someone else or fails to yield license to track officials, management, staff and police or otherwise fails to identify themselves	Suspension of 30 days to permanent suspension

Abuse of Chesterfield County police officer	Suspension/fine/probation/reduction of points
Arrest by Chesterfield County police officer	Permanent ban from race track facility
<u>Abuse of officials in spotter's stand.</u>	<u>Fine/suspension.</u>
<u>Failure to attend driver's meeting. Must have valid reason to miss meeting (car problems during practice)</u>	<u>Fine.</u>
<u>Abuse of officials during driver's meeting. (Driver's meetings are for officials to give information regarding race procedure and scheduling matters. It is not an open forum for driver's to discuss rules, race procedure or express frustrations).</u>	<u>Fine.</u>
<u>Threatening track officials to include will not return to Southside due to calls and procedures, threaten to boycott racetrack or to cause harm.</u>	<u>Suspension/permanent ban from race facility.</u>
