Subject: Sunday Races To Wrap Up 2011 Season – October 16, 2011

4 Championships, 6 Divisions & 11 Races Highlight Sunday Races at Southside Speedway

MIDLOTHIAN, Va. – Everyone will be seeing double on Sunday afternoon at Southside Speedway. Five divisions will run “Twin” races and the season championships will be on the line in four of them. The “Twin” races will give the second and third place men an extra chance to close in on the point’s title and the point’s leader an extra chance to seal the deal.

In the Street Stocks, Mike Gano holds a 13 point advantage over Brian Smith after Smith had problems in the last race. Jason Higginbotham leads Buzz Moore by 14 points in the Champ Karts and Brad Hancock holds an 8 point edge over Brenden Queen in the Legends. Mike Chapman has the most breathing room in the U-Cars, as he holds a 24 point cushion over Michael Hall and Daniel Thomas. All four divisions could still change if the point’s leader experiences any kind of bad luck. The Street Stocks, U-Cars and Legends will run Twin 25 lap races and the Champ Karts will run Twin 15 lappers to settle the 2011 Track Championships.

Two divisions will be new for 2011, but not new to Southside Speedway. The Virginia Mini Cup Racing Association returns for the first time in about 10 years and will run a 25 lap feature, sponsored by Speedy’s Custom Decals. The Pro-6 division, who use to be a regular division at the speedway, will mark their return for the first time in several seasons with Twin 20 lap features.

Pit gates will open at 12 p.m.; front gates open at 2 pm; Qualifying will get underway at 2:30, and the first race will get the green flag at 3 pm. Ticket prices are \$12 for adults; seniors and military are \$10; kids 6 - 12 years of age are \$6; and kids 5 and under get in for free. For more information, log on to www.southsidespeedway.com.

Southside Speedway is a 1/3 mile, paved oval located on Genito Road in Midlothian, VA. The speedway was established in 1959 by J.M. Wilkinson and is currently run by his daughter, Sue W. Clements. The speedway features 8 divisions including Late Models, Modifieds, Grand Stocks, Street Stocks, U-Cars, Champ Karts, Legends and Pro-6. In 2011 the speedway will host 10 nights / afternoons of racing from June 17, 2011 through October 16, 2011.
